Vehicle recovered in Montreal while client vacations in British Columbia

A tracking team was recently dispatched within minutes of receiving and confirming a Boomerang2 theft notification signal from a vehicle in Montreal, whose owner was on a skiing vacation over 4,000 kilometers away on the slopes of Whistler, British Columbia. The tracking team located the missing F-250 less than an hour later on the south shore of Montreal, parked outside a local coffee shop and authorities were immediately notified. As the thief left the coffee shop with a doughnut and coffee in hand, police took the driver into custody.
