Spring begins for Boomerang with three-quarters of a million dollars in incidental recoveries

As the weather gets warmer, thieves are hitting the streets...and Boomerang trackers are not far behind. In the month of April alone, 86 Boomerang-equipped vehicles were recovered which led to another 28 incidental recoveries. April incidentals, valued at over \$730,000, **represent 25% of the total number of vehicles recovered for the month.** The incidental recoveries included the following models; Toyota Camry, Corolla, Matrix and RAV4, GMC trucks, Dodge Caravan, Honda Civic and Volkswagen Golf, Passat and Jetta. The vehicles, with plates from New Brunswick, Saskatchewan, Ontario and Quebec led to 3 arrests with several investigations still underway.
